



## HOW TO ACCESS CLICKVIEW



- ClickView is a Video Learning application that allows teachers and students to access online Curriculum Related Video Material to assist with their teaching and learning.
- You can access ClickView as a student 2 (two) different ways
  - Your teacher may provide you with a ClickView link to view a specific educational video related to your class topic/content.
  - You can go directly to the ClickView website <https://clickview.cnc.wa.edu.au/> to view all ClickView resources.
  - For both options you will need to log into ClickView.
- As a student you can log into ClickView using the same username and password that you use to log into 'Connect'.
- If you are unsure of your username and password, please call the College directly 9746 3500 for assistance.



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- Your teacher may post a ClickView link in the 'Content' section of your Connect class.
- Click on the link provided.
